The Medical Director is responsible for the comprehensive scope/function of the Nisqually Generations Healing Center. This includes providing clinical leadership and oversight for medication/assisted treatment (MAT) services and primary medical care to individuals in the program for treatment of substance use disorders.

Minimum requirements:

- Five (5) years' experience as a Physician
- Licensed in good standing in the state of Washington
- Board certified in Addiction Medicine and Family/Internal Medicine
- Familiarity with management of MAT prescription medications available (Methadone, Buprenorphine, Naltrexone) for SUDs.
- A valid Washington State Driver's license/record, pre-employment drug screen and state/federal criminal background check. This person must be able to work with vulnerable populations including adults and children
