## **Transit Services and Contacts**

## Services currently provided:

- **Shuttle service**. FREE deviated fixed route service "transit runs" between the Upper and Lower Reservation areas, Monday through Friday, with transit connections (Intercity Transit, R/T Transportation) and major stops at:
  - Health Clinic/Library 7:30 am, 11:30 am, 12:30 pm, 1:30 pm, 2:30 pm, 3:30 pm, 4:30 pm, and 5:30 pm.
  - New Tribal Center 8:00 am, 12:00 pm, 2:00 pm, 3:00 pm, 4:00 pm, 5:00 pm, and 6:00 pm.
- **Call request service**. FREE rides beyond the fixed route, Monday through Friday, currently as far as Yelm and Hawks Prairie areas. Please call ahead at least 24-hours if possible.
  - o Mornings 8:30 am to 11:00 am
  - Afternoons 12:30 pm to 2:00 pm
- Transportation of Children.
  - Children under age 12 require adult supervision.
  - Unaccompanied children ages 13-15 require a completed consent form, available from the drivers and transit office.
  - Children over age 15 should carry an ID in case of questions about age.
  - Parents/guardians should complete a consent form ahead of time if possible, so they can ride if there's an immediate need.
- Notes.
  - Scheduled times may be 15 minutes early or late be prepared.
  - If the shuttle bus/van doesn't arrive, contact us to request a ride.
  - $\circ$  There is no service when tribal offices are closed check with the Tribal Center.
  - Policies and procedures are available in the transit office.
  - Nisqually Transit is FREE, but connecting services are fee based –
    R/T is \$1 per ride and Intercity Transit is a small fee. They accept transit passes.
