

NISQUALLY INDIAN TRIBE  
EMERGENCY REGULATION 6-2025/26  
November 6, 2025

In accordance with Section 14.23.02 of Nisqually Tribal Code, Title 14-Chapter 2, as amended by the Tribal Council effective 7/1/91, the Nisqually Fish Commission has adopted the following fishery modification effective November 23, 2025 for the Nisqually River.

**Regulation Modified:** None

**SPECIES:** Chum

**Fishery Type:** Subsistence: Personal subsistence consumption by tribal members and their immediate families.

**No sale of any kind permitted including egg sales.**

**Gear Type:** 1 Gillnet per active fisher, 20 fish per active fisher per week.

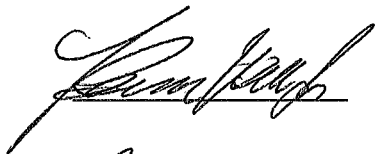
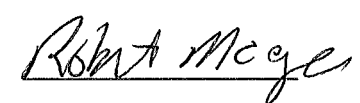
**Area:** Nisqually River mouth to Mouth of Clear Creek.

**Open:** November 23 until further notice not to exceed 2,000 chum. Sunday Noon to Wednesday Noon Daylight Hours Only. Please allow natural resources staff to sample all of your catch.

**SPECIAL SPECIES CONCERN:** GREEN AND WHITE STURGEON

**FISHERY TYPE:** INCIDENTAL; ALL STURGEON CAUGHT DURING ANY DIRECTED FISHERY IS TO BE RELEASED ALIVE.
