In accordance with Section 14.23.02 of Nisqually Tribal Code, Title 14-Chapter 2, as amended by the Tribal Council effective 7/1/91, the Nisqually Fish Commission has adopted the following fishery modification effective November 23, 2025 for the Nisqually River.

Chum

Fishery Type: Subsistence: Personal subsistence consumption by tribal members and their

immediate families.

No sale of any kind permitted including egg sales.

Gear Type: 1 Gillnet per active fisher, 20 fish per active fisher per week.

Area: Nisqually River mouth to Mouth of Clear Creek.

Open: November 23 until further notice not to exceed 2,000 chum. Sunday Noon to Wednesday Noon Daylight Hours Only. Please allow natural resources staff to sample all of your catch.

SPECIAL SPECIES CONCERN: GREEN AND WHITE STURGEON FISHERY TYPE: INCEDENTAL; ALL STURGEON CAUGHT DURING ANY DIRECTED FISHERY IS TO BE RELEASED ALIVE.
