## **NTHWC Medical Program**

Nisqually Tribal Health & Wellness Center offers family practice outpatient medical care along with behavioral health, dental, pharmacy, and traditional healing services. We provide a full range of traditional and Western medical care throughout the patient life cycle.

## **Direct Services:**

- Primary care for individuals and families, including acute illnesses, chronic health conditions, and disease management (e.g., diabetes, hypertension, asthma)
- Pediatric services (well child exams, sports physicals, and comprehensive care for infants, children, and adolescents)
- Nurse triage and care management
- COVID-19 testing and vaccinations (routine and seasonal immunizations for all ages)
- Maternal and infant health services, including prenatal care and family planning
- Diabetes care and education, including podiatry and nutrition counseling
- Cancer screenings (breast, cervical, colorectal, and others)
- Long- and short-acting contraception options and women's wellness services (Pap smears, breast exams, preventive and reproductive health)
- Gender-affirming care
